

332 The following deed of Conveyance from William Stringer to Benjamin Meath being proven before David Goodlett Esq. by the oath of Edward Stringer was presented and Recorded this 20<sup>th</sup> day of August 1799 State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina

July 5<sup>th</sup> one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine Know all men by these presents that I William Stringer of the state aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me paid by Benjamin Meath of the County of Greenville have granted Bargained sold and Released and by these presents do grant Bargain sell and Release unto the said Benjamin Meath part of a tract of land lying and being in the County aforesaid and being on the branches of the North fork of Saluda River beginning at a white oak on Thomas Farrows line running N. 50. W. 30 chain and fifty links to a Red Oak. N. 12 chain to a pine. S. 60 E. 23 chain & fifty links to a hicknut N. 15 E to a Gum Station from thence running a direct course on the top of the Scaer Mountain to the fork of Wheaton Meath's Branch thence a straight line to the top of Lion house. 406 and then to a red line in the gap of the Mountain from thence to a stake & from thence to the Beginning Corner containing four hundred acres & the same more or less being granted by app'tion to William Stringer bearing date the eighth day of January one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven and conveyed from me William Stringer to Benjamin Meath together with all and singular the rights members and hind'aments and app'tinances to the said premises belonging in any wise app'taining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto said Benjamin Meath his heirs and assigns forever and do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Benjamin Meath his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and from every other person laying any lawful claim to the said premises under or in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year first above written Signed sealed and delivered in the presents of

332 The following deed of Conveyance from Robert Goodgion to William Goodgion being proven before David Goodlett Esq. by the oath of Henry Prince was presented and Recorded this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1799

Know all men by these presents that I Robert Goodgion of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars in hand paid by William Goodgion of S<sup>c</sup> County the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold & Released & by these presents do Grant bargain & sell unto the said W<sup>m</sup> Goodgion two hundred and seven tenths of land it being part of two tracts originally granted to the said Robert Goodgion the 5<sup>th</sup> of March 1790 lying & being in said County & on the Branches of the middle fork of Sygar also the other tract was granted to S<sup>d</sup> Robert Goodgion on the seventh day of March 1796 lying ~~on the~~ Hammels Beavercan of the middle fork of Sygar river beginning each other Beginning at a post oak thence N. 21. W. 30 chain to a post oak on the corner of Benjamin Redestons land thence N. 55. W. 27 chain 30 links to a white oak thence S. 28. W. 9 chain to a black oak thence S. 50. W. 9 chain to a hicknut thence S. 50. W. 22 chain to a hicknut, thence S. 36. E. 69 chain to a stake on Meath & Stringers line thence along S<sup>d</sup> line to a corner thence along his line until it meets a marked line that is the line of one hundred acres that was conveyed to William Wood by S<sup>d</sup> Robert Goodgion which said line leads to the beginning corner including two hundred and seven tenths acres be the same more or less together with all & singular the rights members & app'tinances thereto app'taining to said premises I have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Goodgion his heirs & assigns forever against myself my heirs & assigns and against all persons claiming under or by us forever In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 6<sup>th</sup> July one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine.
