



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The following deed of conveyance from Archable Fowler to Sepe Suggs being proven before David Goodlett Esq^r by the oath of William Rodgers was presented and recorded this 10th day of September 1799

This indenture made this 5th day of January one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight and of the Independence of the United States of America the Twenty Third between Archable Fowler of the State of Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part & Sepe Suggs of the County and State afores^d of the other part with respect to the consideration of the sum of Thirty Pounds Sterling law full money of the State in hand paid by Sepe Suggs hath bargained and sold & by these presents doth bargain sell and make conveyance to s^d Sepe Suggs a certain Plantation or Tract of Land lying in Greenville County on the Head branches of Rich Land Creek of Reddy River which Sepe Suggs now lives on and hath such boundary when cast beginning on a Black Oak Corner running thence N. 40. E. 13. C. to a Spanish Oak Corner thence west 40 to a State Corner thence S. 75. W. 15. C. to a Post Oak Corner thence N. 72. W. 18 to a Black Oak Corner thence S. 5. W. 13. to Elm Corner thence N. 72. W. 10. C. to a State Corner thence S. 65. W. to a conditional Black Oak Corner thence to a conditional Black Oak Corner on Stads worth line thence S. 6. E. C. to a Post Oak Corner thence S. 70. E. 25. 25 to State Corner from thence to the beginning it being a part of a tract of Land containing Eight hundred and Forty acres Granted unto Archable Fowler from under the

hand of his Excellency William Moultrie Esq^r bearing date the fourth day of February one thousand seven hundred and ninety Three Recorded in Book G. 8th Page 9 he hath Granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain sell and convey unto the said Sepe Suggs the above described Tract of Land containing one hundred and fifty acres let it be more or less together with the woods waters hereditaments and appertinances unto said Land belonging or in any wise appertaining & Reversion & reversions Remainder and Residues Rents Issues and profits thereof to have & to hold the Granted premises of the above mentioned Tract of Land containing one hundred & fifty acres more or less unto the said Sepe Suggs his heirs & adm^{rs} as assigns forever and that the s^d Archable Fowler his heirs Executors adm^{rs} or assigns doth covenant and agree to and with the s^d Sepe Suggs his heirs & adm^{rs} or assigns shall at all times hereafter peaceably & quietly occupy possess & enjoy the s^d Tract of Land containing one hundred and fifty acres more or less from all former bargains sales mortgages judgments rights and downwards & other incumbrances what soever and the said Archable Fowler his heirs & adm^{rs} as assigns doth warrant and defend the above described Tract of Land from all and every other person or persons what soever that may lay any claim or title therunto hereafter when of s^d Archable Fowler hath hereunto set his hand & fixed his seal y^e day and year above written
