To all People to whom these presents shall come I John Crow Foster do send greeting Know ye that I the said John Crow Foster of the State of Carolina & Greenville County for and in consideration of the love and good will and affections I have and do bear to wards my loving White Son Stewart Brown Foster of the State and County aforesaid I have given and granted and by these presents do freely give and Grant unto the said John Stewart Brown Foster and his heirs for ever two Negro children by the name of Werney & Hall now being in my possession until the signing and delivering of these presents at which time in the presence of the witnesses I have delivered the above named Negroes together with this Instrument of writing viz Werney and Hall to the named John Stewart Brown Foster and his heirs for ever to have & to hold the above named Negroes to him and his heirs from hence forth & forever as his property absolutely without any manner of condition in witness whereof I have here unto set my hand & seal this thirtieth day of December one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine
