381 The following Deed of Conveyance from David Goodlett
to Alexander Waddell being proven before Jesse Carter
by the oath of John Mackbeth was presented and recorded
this 11th day of April 1800.

State of Carolina Greenville District
Know all men by these presents that I David Goodlett
of the State and District aforesaid doth for and in Consi-
deration of the sum of Fifteen Dollars to me in hand
paid by Alexander Waddell of the said

381 District Alex Goodlett bargained sold and relax unto the said
Alexander Waddell all that part of my land East of the Widow
Howels ~~Plantation~~ Plantation being part of a tract of four
Hundred and seventy three acres of Land Originally granted to
John Timmons the 15th of October 1798 and Conveyed by the
said Timmons to Francis Howel and from the said Howel to
said D. Goodlett Now this Indenture Witnesseth that I the
said D. Goodlett have here by granted unto the said Alexander
Waddell one hundred and eleven acres of ~~the~~ the aforesaid
Beginning at the said Goodletts Corner on a red oak and runs
north 45^o E. 25^o Chain Crossing richland Creek to a red oak
Corner on said Goodletts line thence S. 45^o E. 30 Chain 50 Links to a chestnut
Corner thence S. 45^o W. to a stake at richland Creek thence N. 70^o W. 20 Chain
to a Stake thence to the beginning containing 111 acres be the same
more or less, Also 182 acres of one other tract granted to the said
D. Goodlett the first day of July 1799 Joining the above land Beginning
at a black oak Corner on the west side of richland Creek and runs
N. 115^o E. to a pine corner of D. Lesters land thence S. 70^o E. 34 Chains
to black oak Corner on Watsons line thence S. 35^o W. 6 Chains
50 links to a Stake corner & mark thence S. 50^o E. to a Hiory Station
on J. Watsons line near a branch thence S. 115^o W. to Alstons Corner
a red oak thence to the beginning be the same more or less
Together with all and singular the Rights members and apper-
tenances there unto belonging (Except the privilege of the water
course of richland Creek which I do except to my self to build
a grist mill on if wanted) unto the said Alexander Waddell his
heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs
& adm^{rs} to warrant and for ever defend the aforesaid
mentioned land tracts of land unto the aforesaid Alexander
Waddell his heirs and assigns against my self my heirs and
from all and every other person or persons what soever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
there of Witness my hand and seal this 23rd March 1800.
