that I Alexander M Gilbert of the County of Rutherford and
State of North Carolina for and in consideration of Seventy
dollars Current money to me in hand paid by John Chandler
have Granted bargained sold and Released and by these presents
do Grant bargain sell and Release unto the said John Chandler
one hundred and fifty acres of Land lying in Greenville
County on Buck horn Creek beginning on a chesnut about 296
Poles from the Poplar Corner near the sulphur Spring running
thence North forty five East one hundred and sixty poles
Crossing buck horn Creek and a small branch to a black oak
near the branch thence north forty five west one hundred and
fifty poles Crossing said small branch to a stake thence south forty
five west one hundred and sixty poles to a post oak thence south
forty five East one hundred and fifty Poles Crossing buck
horn branch to the beginning being part of the same
tract Granted to William Gilbert the fifth day of Feb^r 1787
Reference being there unto had will more fully appear —

being proven before Robert Cook Esq^r by the oath of William
Cornelius was presented and Recorded this 16th day of April 1800

Greenville County } Know all men by these presents that I
Dennis Duff of the County aforesaid in the state aforesaid
and in consideration of one hundred Dollars to me in hand already
paid by Philip Duff of the said County in the state aforesaid
the Receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged have granted
bargained sold and Released and by these presents do Grant bar-
gain sell and Release unto the said Philip Duff one hundred acres
of Land lying and being in Greenville County on both sides of the
north fork of of Saluda or Chicheno River being part of
a tract of Land Granted to Dennis Duff the fifth day of
June 1786 by his Excellency William Moutrie and Recorded
in Secretarys office in Grant Book 133 the said Hundred acres
of Land to have such lines and boundaries as will be herein
mentioned that is to say beginning on a Forked ash on the
west side of the said North fork of Saluda River thence run-
ning East and west from said forked ash to the said Dennis
Duff line on both sides of the said River the same
being a conditional line between the said Dennis Duff
and the said Philip Duff thence up the said two lines to
