




In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 28<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine and in the twentieth year of American Independence





384 The following deed of Conveyance from Thomas Benson to Absolom Thompson being proven before Reubin Barreto Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of William Tubb was presented and Recorded this 18<sup>th</sup> day April 1800  
This Indenture made this twenty third day of August one thousand seven hundred and ninety four Between Thomas

385 Benson of the state of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina and Greenville County of the one part and Absolom Thompson of the said State and County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Benson for the Consideration of the sum of Forty Pounds to him in hand paid by the said Absolom Thompson the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the said Thomas Benson have granted Bargained and sold unto the s<sup>d</sup> Absolom Thompson part of one Tract of Land on the sink hole fork of Tiger River originally granted to the said Thomas Benson the twenty sixth day of January one thousand seven hundred and eighty five by his Excellency Benjamin Guard Esq<sup>r</sup> Beginning at a Red oak the Beginning Corner of the original survey thence S 03 1/2 Chain 62 links to a Red oak Thence E 31 Chain 62 links to a Stake Thence N 31 Chain 62 Links to a stake thence west 31 Chain 62 Links to the beginning it containing one hundred acres more or less the said Thomas Benson do warrant and forever defend the aforesaid tract of Land to the said Absolom Thompson his heirs and so forth free and clear from me my heirs and from all and every person whatsoever having any legal claim the same in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day and date above mentioned

The State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina Washington District Know all Men by this presents that I John Champion of the County and State aforesaid for and in consideration of one hundred and seventy Dollars to me paid by Ellet Boling of the County and
