


Know all men by these presents that I George Tankersly of the State and District aforesaid for the consideration of the sum of Fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Jeroniah Smith of the state & District aforesaid Have granted bargained sold and Release unto Jeroniah Smith part of a tract of Land Originally Granted to Humphrey Scroggins by his Excellency Benjamin Guerrard Governor of the state of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina at dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1784 the above mentioned land lying and being on the waters of the Golden Grove Creek bounded by Joseph Bensons, Waddy Thompsons and William Bensons land containing 15 acres more or less and I the said George Tankersly do warrant and forever defend the above mentioned land to Jeroniah Smith and his heirs free and clear from me and my heirs and from all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same. 

The following Deed of <sup>Gift</sup> ~~conveyance~~ from Gershon Kelley to Anne Paulding being proven before Joseph Dunklin Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Mary Kelly was presented and recorded this 13<sup>th</sup> day of May 1800 State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina To all people to whom these presents writing come, be seen or made known Greeting — Know ye that I Gershon Kelley of Greenville County in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the very Great love and Affection that I bear unto my beloved Daughter Anne Paulding, of the County and State aforesaid and for an ~~in~~ consideration of the sum of ten Shillings Sterling

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of and delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof I do here by acknowledge, and my self there with fully satisfied and paid and for other good Causes and Considerations me thereunto moving have given Granted and Confirmed unto the said Anne Paulding's Heirs of her Body Lawfully begotten forever, do fully, freely, and absolutely give Grant and Confirmed, unto the Heirs of my said Daughter one negrowoman named Phillas, and her Daughter named Charlotte, and there further I give to have and to hold the said Negros Phillas and her Daughter Charlotte unto the said Heirs of my Daughter Lawfully begotten, left to care of Robert and Anne Paulding their Natural life time, and I the said Gershon Kelley for myself my Executors administrators and assigns forever shall and warrant and defend by these presents In witness whereof I the s<sup>d</sup> Gershon Kelley have set my hand and seal this thirty first day of August in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and ninety nine in the twenty fourth year of America's Independence
