I know all men by these presents that Lemuel James Atston of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in Consideration of one hundred dollars to me paid by Ezias Carle of the County & State aforesaid have Granted bargained, sold and Released and by these presents do Grant bargain sell and Release unto the said Ezias Carle all those parts or lots of Land lying and being in the State and County aforesaid this & in the Village of Pleasantburg at Greenville Court House the same being part of Two Lots of Land numbered in the Chart of said Village N^o 11 & N^o 12 and to be laid out as follows Viz, Beginning at a stake 3x at the Corner of the Goal or near it, running thence N. 15 1/2 degrees E. 52 1/2 feet to a stake 3x, thence N. 74 1/2 W. 200 feet to a stake 3x, thence S. 15 1/2 degrees W. 52 1/2 to a stake, thence to the beginning containing half an acre, be the same more or less, Together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Ezias Carle his Heirs and assigns forever and I do here by being myself my Heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Ezias Carle his Heirs and assigns against myself and my Heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand and seal this nineteenth day of March in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred
