

Bargain and sell and convey unto John Champron all that  
tract of Land that I once sold to Edward Woolridge the bound  
whereon said Woolridge now lives containing one Hun-  
dred and seventy five acres be the same more or less ft  
being part of a tract Granted unto Alexander Ray by his  
excellency Benjamin Guillard Esq. Governor Lying in the  
County aforesaid West side of Rudy River and bounded as  
follows Beginning on said River running west to a post oak
