



 The following Deed of Conveyance from Henry Wood to Elias Earle being
 Proven before Thomas Edwards Esq. by the oath of William Wood was
 presented and Recorded this 27 day of June 1800

 Know all men by these presents that Henry Maken Wood of the State and District
 aforesaid for and in consideration of ~~ten~~ thousand Dollars to him hand paid
 have Granted bargained and sold to Elias Earle a tract or Parcel of whereon William
 Wood Lives Containing two hundred and Fifty acres more or less within the
 Courses hereafter mentioned being part of Three surveys one Granted to the
 said Henry M Wood one Granted to Joseph Dimes and the other to William
 Right and beginning on a Stake on River bank at the upper end of the bottom
 and running S 50 East 4 Chain to a hickory thence E 4 Ch^{rs} to a white oak
 corner near a branch thence S 8 East 10 Chain down the edge of the
 Cotton to a large white oak thence North 70 E. 22 Chain 50 L^{ts} to a
 Stake on Woods line to being Joseph Dimes old corner thence N 14
 East 12 Chain to an old Poplar stump by branch thence S 8 East
 7 Chain to a Red oak thence S 35 East 38 Chain to a pine thence S 38
 Chain to a Red oak thence S 70 W 24 Chain to Red oak on Stone Point
 below Alphins field thence N 52 W 16 Ch^{rs} to a large Red oak thence
 North 72 West 30 Chain to a stake by William Woods stable thence
 thence S 76 West 35 Chain to a hickory on the bank of the River thence
 to the beginning containing Two hundred and Fifty acres more or less
 within the Courses above described Together with all and singular the
 Rents Issues Profits Commodities and appurtenances belonging or
 in any wise incident or appertaining thereto to have and to hold

 all her Right of Power of the within mentioned premises unto Elias Earle his heirs and
 assigns forever given under my hand and seal this 6th of March 1800

The following Deed of Conveyance from Thomas M'Daniel To Thomas
 Hambleton being proven before Joseph Dunklin Esq. by the oath of William
 Dunklin was presented and Recorded this 27th day of June 1800
 The State of S Carolina — Know all men by these presents that
 I Thomas M'Daniel of the County of Union in the State aforesaid for
 an inconsideration of the sum of Fifty Pounds Sterling to me paid
 by Hambleton of the County of Greenville & State aforesaid have granted
 bargained sold and Released and by these presents do grant bargain sell
 and Release unto the said Thomas Hambleton a Plantation or tract
 of Land containing seventy five acres more or less (it being part
 of Three hundred and Forty acres Granted to the said M'Daniel) and
 bounded by lands of the said Thomas Hambleton Hugh Let Sullivan
 Joseph Ship Sol Chandler & Thomas Lewis lying on the branches
 of Rudy River in Greenville County Together with all and singular
 the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premi-
 ses belonging or in any wise appertaining I have and all and
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas Hambleton
