


18 Eli Norman hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said William Ferguson a Plantation or tract of Land containing forty acres lying and being in Granville County on waters of brush Creek Beginning on a red oak and running N 83 W 31 to a red oak thence S 30 W to a certain distance sufficient to make the quantity of Forty acres to a stake thence S 40 E 15 to a stake thence with the old line S 53 E to a red oak thence S 64 E 21 to a Post oak thence S 20 E 13 to the beginning which said Tract of Land of Forty acres with all and every of its appurtenances the said Eli Norman doth from himself and his heirs & from all and every other Person & Persons will warrant & for ever defend to the said William Ferguson his heirs and assigns forever In witness whereof the said Eli Norman hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day & year above written
