 Singular the rights members Accoutments and appurte-
 nances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise
 appertaining To have and to hold all and Singular the
 Premises before mentioned unto the said John Barrett his
 Heirs and assigns for ever and I do here by bind myself
 my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and
 for ever defend all and Singular the said Premises unto
 the said John Barrett his Heirs and assigns against my
 self my heirs and against all and Every Other Person
 whomsoever Lawfully Claiming or to Claim the same
 or any part thereof In witness whereof I the said
