

The following Deed of Conveyance from John Blasinger  
to John Westfield being proven before John Burns Esq.  
by the oath of Mobery Hall was presented and Recorded this  
16<sup>th</sup> day of October 1800

The State of South Carolina

I know all men by these presents that I John Blasinger  
of Greenville District in the state aforesaid planter  
in consideration of nine hundred and sixty dollars  
to me paid by John Westfield of the District and state  
aforesaid planter have granted bargained sold and  
released and by these presents do grant bargain sell  
and Release unto the said John Westfield all that  
tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the  
District and state aforesaid and on both sides of the  
Golden Grove Creek waters of Saluda River the same  
being one half of a Tract of Land Originally  
granted to Henry Middleton Esq. for six hundred  
and Forty acres and the one half of said survey hereby  
mentioned to be conveyed Runs as follows, Viz, Begin-  
ning on a white oak of the Original Tract and  
from thence S<sup>o</sup> 45<sup>o</sup> W<sup>o</sup> 80 chain to a black Oak  
B<sup>o</sup> 7<sup>o</sup> thence S<sup>o</sup> 45<sup>o</sup> E<sup>o</sup> 40 ch<sup>o</sup> or one half the  
Distance of said Course to a Walnut Corner  
agreed on by the Parties thence across the Original  
Survey S<sup>o</sup> 45<sup>o</sup> E<sup>o</sup> 80 chain to a Walnut
