70 to the begining together with all and singular the rights  
remainder hereditaments and appurtenances to the said  
premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining  
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the said John Barnett his heirs and assigns  
for ever and I A. the Meeks do hereby bind myself my  
heirs executors administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and  
singular the said premises unto the said John Barnett  
his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs  
and against every other person whomsoever lawfully  
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof  
witness my hand and seal this 30<sup>th</sup> day of September in  
the year of our Lord 1794 and in the 2d year of the  
Independance of the United States of America
