The following Deed of Conveyance from George Salmon
to John Atkins being proven before Robert Cook Esq.
by the oath of Robert Cox was presented and Recorded this
17th day of Feb. 1801.

State of South Carolina - Know all men by these
presents that I George Salmon of Greenville County
and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Twenty
Dollars to me paid by John Atkins of the State and
County aforesaid have granted bargained sold and
Released and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto the said John Atkins planta-
tion tract or parcel of Land containing one hun-
dred and Eighty acres be the same more or less situated
in Greenville County aforesaid on both sides of
French's branch of Chickarona river waters of
Saluda river beginning on a Spanish Oak on the
west side of said branch running thence due east
nineteen chains fifty links to a post oak thence
North Thirty five degrees East Thirly Eight chains
fifty links to a stake thence North forty six degrees
West to the back line of my fifteen hundred acres
