

The following deed of conveyance from Samuel Mosley to Martin Hewitt being proven before John Burns Esq. by the oath of Daniel Ayres as presented and recorded this 3rd day of March 1807

State of Carolina know all men by these presents that I Samuel Mosley of Greenville County and state aforesaid planter in the consideration of three hundred dollars to me paid by Martin Hewitt of the county and state aforesaid planter have granted bargained sold and released & by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the s^d Martin Hewitt all that tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the county and state aforesaid on Saluda river containing 130 acres be the same more or less and bounding as follows to wit beginning at the mouth of the mill creek from thence down s^d river to John Mitchen corner from thence along said line to Mary Swells line to her Spring branch thence down her Spring branch to the mill creek thence down the said creek to the beginning corner this said being part of that tract of land conveyed from Jesse Hobson to Samuel Mosley bearing date Jan^y 18th 1800 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the s^d premises belong or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Martin Hewitt his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Martin Hewitt his heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs and against every person lawfully claiming or to
