 and last mentioned to the said Miriam Bryan her
 heirs Executors administrators or assigns from hence
 forth as her and their goods and chattels absolutely
 without any manner of contention excepting the
 following that is to say that I the said Elizabeth
 Rogers do receive for my self the use of all and sin-
 gular the said goods & chattels during my natural life
 On W^{ch}ness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and seal the 18th day of March A^D 1771.
