said Hugh Roark all that plantation, or tract of land
containing eighty acres more or less situate lying and
being in Greenville District and state, afore said on Bra-
shy Creek running N 60 E on Hugh Roarks land thence
running by a marked line, on part of the same tract
originally granted to Charles Estes running on a tract
of land originally granted to Polly Lewis it being the same
tract conveyed to me by James Dyer by a deed of convey-
ance bearing date the 1st day of December 1800 Together
with all and singular the rights hereditaments and
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in
any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto
the said Hugh Roark his heirs and assigns forever and
I do here by bind my self my heirs Executors & Admini-
strators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said Hugh Roark his heirs &
assigns against myself and my heirs only Witness
my hand and seal this twenty second day of December
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred &
in the twenty fifth year of the sovereignty and Independ-
dence of the United States of America.
