The following deed of conveyance from Matthew Wian to
George W. Earle being proven before Tho^s. Edwards Esquire
by the oath of Baylis Earle Jun^r. was presented and recorded
this 7th day of March 1801—

The State of Carolina. — Know all men by
these presents that I Matthew Wynne of Greenville
District in the State, aforesaid in consideration of
Forty four Dollars to me in hand paid by George Washing-
ton Earle, of the same place have granted bargained sold
and released and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto the said George W. Earle his
heirs and assigns forever all that piece or parcel of
Land containing seventeen acres, be the same more or
less, agreeable to the following courses, beginning
on a stake on said Earles line, formerly Hawkins
line, being said Wynns corner, thence with said line
south sixty eight degrees west 35th Ch^s 60 links to
a small ash on the bank of a branch, thence up the
meanders of said branch to the head, commencing on a
black gum 37, thence south seventy four degrees East
nineteen chains to a red oak on said Wynns side line,
thence with said line to the beginning, being a part
