

The following deed of conveyance from John Wilson to Nicholas White being proven before James McGill Esquire by the oath of Solomon White was presented and recorded this 5th day of June 1807

This Indenture made this fourth day of February one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven & in the twenty first year of American Independence between John Wilson of Laurens County and State of South Carolina of the One part and Nicholas White of Granville County and State aforesaid of the other part Whereas in and by a certain grant bearing date the fifth day of June 1786 recorded in grants Book M. B. M. page 3 sign by his excellency William Moultrie Esquire then governor and commander and in chief in and over the state aforesaid did give unto Robert Goodwin a plantation or tract of one hundred and fifty two acres of land to be lying ninety six & a half on both sides of Durbins creek then by lawfull titles to Daniel Wrights then from the said Daniel Wright then by lawfull titles to John Wilsons now this indenture Witnesseth that the said John Wilson hath for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Nicholas White the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained sold made over conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth bargain sell alien make over confirm unto the said Nicholas White all that part of the above mentioned tract of Land lying on the south side of Durbins Creek situate lying and being in the County of Granville beginning at a stake B of the stable and running thence 65° E 31 ch 25 L to a stake B thence S 25 W to the beginning supposed to include 52 acres
