Barton being proven before Meubin Banitt Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of  
John Batts was presented and recorded this 21<sup>st</sup> day of July 1801  
This indenture made the twenty fourth day of January in  
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one  
and in the twenty sixth year of American Independence  
between Ann Eastly of State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina and Gun-  
ville District of the one part and Ann Barton and Mary  
Graham of the state and District aforesaid Daughters  
of the aforesaid Ann Eastly of the other part witnesseth  
that the said Ann Eastly as well for and in consideration  
of the natural love and affection which she has and  
beareth unto her said beloved daughters Ann & Mary  
as also of the sum of one hundred dollars to her in  
hand paid by the said Ann and Mary she the said Ann  
Eastly hath given granted and confirmed and by these pre-  
sents doth give grant and confirm unto her said Daughters  
Ann and Mary One Negro woman Slave named Jude
