in the state aforesaid in consideration of three hundred
dollars to me in hand paid by David Tranum Jun^r
of the District and State aforesaid have granted bargain
ed sold and released and by these presents do grant bar
gain sell and release unto the said David Tranum
all that plantation or tract of land containing
one hundred and eighty acres by the same more or less
situate in Greenville District lying on horse creek
beginning on a hickory 3^d running thence N 29^o W
37^d 36 Links on Ben^o Arnolds line to a stake 3^d
thence N 61^o E 47 Chains on David Transendent^r
line to a red Oak 3^d thence S 41^o E 17 chains on Tho^o
Thomas^r line to a white Oak 3^d thence S 21^o E 11 chains
on said Thomas line to a red Oak 3^d thence S 30^o E 40
links on W^m Williams line to a red Oak 3^d thence S 49^o W
47^d 50 links on said Williams line to a hickory 3^d thence
S 29^o E 44 ch on Ben^o Arnolds line to a sweet gum 3^d near
horse creek thence Down the meanders of said creek to the mouth
of a branch thence up said branch to the beginning measuring
50 links on each side of said creek for the use of said Thomas
Camp Together with all and singular the rights and mem
