

Memorandum that on the Twenty Eighth day of August 1793 quit and payable possession & enjoyment of the within granted land & premises was done & Delivered by the Within mentioned Marcus Littleton unto the within named Charles Littleton according to form and effect of the within written state in presence of Thos. J. of Charles Littleton the sum of thirty pounds Sterling it being the full Consideration money mentioned in the within written Deed - Est - George Wadlington and Elmore ^{his} Wadlington Marcus Littleton ^{mark}

South Carolina Newberry District come before me personally George B. Wadlington according to a due form of Law and sayeth on oath that he did see Marcus Littleton sign seal & deliver the within Deed of conveyance unto the within mentioned Charles Littleton for the use & purpose within mentioned and that he did see Elmore Wadlington sign his name together with being as a witness to the same sworn to & subscribed this 14th Nov. 1801. before me Wm. Spivey J. C. George B. Wadlington

Ry of Greenville District and state aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars to me paid by William Persico of the State and District aforesaid as receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Persico a certain tract or parcel of land containing by Estimation one hundred acres in the same more or less situate in Greenville District
