


with a line of marked trees agreed on by the Parties to a Post Oak Corner

 line, thence S 44. <sup>o</sup> E to a Stake, thence S 57. <sup>o</sup> W. till it strikes Saluda  
 River, thence up the Meanders of the said River to the beginning, it  
 being part of a Tract of Land Originally granted to James Blasingame  
 the 2<sup>d</sup> day of April 1787. by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney Esq<sup>r</sup> Con-  
 taining One hundred Acres more or less, to him the said Collins Bot-  
 ding his heirs &c. free and clear from me my heirs & from all and  
 every person or persons whatsoever: In witness of the same I have  
 hereunto set my hand & Seal the day & date first above mentioned.

 by these presents that We David Goodlett and Rachel Goodlett  
 for and in consideration of Fifty pounds Current money to them  
 in hand paid by Elias Earle. Have granted bargained sold &  
 Released, and by these presents Do Grant bargain sell & Release  
 unto the said Elias Earle All that part of Land lying in the S. off  
 Corner of my Land Beginning on my White Oak Corner, running S. 45.  
 East Seven Chains, to a large White Oak Corner made by Goodlett  
 & Earle that stands on the line thence turning N. East Course two  
 Six Chains to a Stake by the Creek, below the Corner of the Mark  
 Mill, thence turning a N. West Course nine Chains & 50 links to a  
 Hickory near the Road, thence to the beginning nine chain inclu-  
 ding the said Elias Earles Mill, Distillery, Tan Yard &c. Containing  
 six acres more or less - within the Courses & bounds above mentioned  
 as laid off by Elias Earle & David Goodlett, being part of a Tract  
 of Land, Originally granted to David Goodlett the 13<sup>th</sup> of October  
 1784. by his Excellency Benjamin Guwain Esq<sup>r</sup> the then Governor  
 of South Carolina as by the said and Grant will more fully ap-  
 pear: Together with all and singular the Rights members be-  
 accitements and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or  
 in any wise Incident or appertaining: To have and to hold all  
 & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Elias  
 Earle his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself  
 my heirs Executors Adm<sup>rs</sup> &c. to warrant and for ever defend  
 all and singular the premises unto Elias Earle his heirs
