This Indenture made the Twenty eighth Day of March one thou-
 sand seven hundred and ninety five, between John Brunk of South
 Carolina Greenville County of the one part, and Nathan Reed of the
 State and County aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the S^r
 John Brunk for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
 Pounds Sterling Money to him in hand paid at and before the sealing
 and delivering of the presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
 ledged, have granted bargained sold aliened Released Confirmed
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and confirm unto the
 said Nathan Reed his heirs and assigns for ever, All that part of
 a certain Tract of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of
 Greenville on Mountain Creek the Waters of Saluda River
 Originally Granted to Robert Pinner, being said Tract of Land whereon
 said John Brunk now lives, Beginning at a Hickory Corner on the
 Wagon Road thence Meandering with said Road to a small Red
 Oak Corner on the South side of S^r Road, thence along a conditional
 line to a dead Red Oak at the Corner of W^o Ledford's fence, thence
 N. W. 55^o to a Stake near a red oak the original corner, thence
 N. E. 35^o forty seven and a half links to a red oak corner at
 Fork of Mountain Creek on the original line, & near a Persimmon
 on the North, thence down said Mountain Fork of Mountain
 Creek with the Meanders thereof to an ash tree a corner, thence
 to the beginning containing one hundred & ten acres, be the
 same more or less - being now in actual possession of the said
 Nathan Reed. Together with all and singular the Trees waters
 & Conditions to Rights Members and appurtenances whatsoever
