This Indenture made this first day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand  
 seven hundred and ninety five between Joseph Reed of the South Greenville  
 County and South West Territory of the one part, and Nathan Reed of Greenville  
 County and South Carolina of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Joseph  
 Reed for and in consideration of the sum of sixty "Pounds" Sterling in hand paid  
 by the said Nathan Reed hath granted bargained sold aliened Released  
 confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien  
 release and confirm unto the said Nathan Reed All that Tract of Land  
 containing Twenty acres (more or less) being part of a Tract of land originally  
 granted to W. Pines beginning at the fork of Mountain Creek, and  
 running up the North fork of said Creek to a Red Oak Station on the Ori-  
 ginal Line, thence N. W. to a Red Oak corner, Thence S. W. 35<sup>o</sup> 47' Ch  
 to a Persimmon Station on the South fork of said Creek from thence Me-  
 -andering with said Creek to the beginning - with all the Members  
 Rights and appurtenances thereto belonging, Situate lying and  
 being as aforesaid and all the Houses Buildings, Meadows Common
