This Indenture made this ninth day of March in the year of our Lord one thou-
 sand eight hundred and two between William Earley of Greenville Dis-
 trict and State of South Carolina of the one part, and Labourn Loftis of
 the District and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that for and
 in Consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to him in
 hand paid by said Loftis before the sealing and delivering of these pre-
 sents the Receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged hath bargained
 and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell, also confirm
 and convey unto Labourn Loftis his heirs and assigns for ever a certain
 Tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being on both sides of Doctors
 Creek the N. part of S. Tigger, Containing one hundred acres be the
 same more or less, it being a part of that Tract granted to William Davis
 the 2nd day of January 1780. Containing two hundred acres, having
 each shape & marks as follows Beginning on a Locust it being a
 Conditional Corner between Kenneth Holcomb & Henry Bates from thence
 to a Branch on S. Creek, thence same Course to a Stake & on the same Line then
 to a black Gum then to N.E. 62 .. 31 to Chestnut then 40 to red Oak & P.
 Oak Station, then to the beginning Corner. Together with all and singular
 Woods waters water Courses Rights members and appurtenances whatsoever
 with the Reversions, and remainders Right of Greens & profits thereof and every
 part and parcel thereof unto said Labourn Loftis his heirs ^{per} & assigns
 for ever: To have and to hold the said plantation or Tract of Land containing
 one hundred acres more or less unto the proper use and behoof of S. Labourn
 Loftis his heirs & adm^r and assigns, and he the said William Earley for
 himself his heirs & adm^r & assigns shall and will warrant & for ever
 defend the same bargained premises with every part and parcel thereof
 in any wise thence belonging unto Labourn Loftis his heirs & adm^rors
 & assigns against all persons whatsoever lawfully claiming any Right or
 Title to any part thereof. In witness whereof he the S. William Earley hath
 hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year above written
