E. on Vacant Land containing by Estimation one hundred and twenty acres, be the same more or less, the same being part of a Tract of Land granted William Savage on the 7th day of May 1787. and recorded in Books L L L page 328 reference had will fully appear and the said tract of Land sold and conveyed by the said William Savage unto John Kilbreath and the said John Kilbreath sold & conveyed the said Tract of Land unto the aforesaid Job Heald, and by the said Job Heald sold and unto the said Humphrey Posey, To have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned
