 vage of the State aforesaid and County of Greenville, in consideration of
 of the sum of two hundred dollars to him paid by William Duncan
 of the County and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released
 unto the said William Duncan a certain tract or parcel of land con-
 taining One hundred and Sixty Acres be the same more or less,
 beginning on a large Pine, thence running North along Griffins
 line to a pine corner, thence North West to a Post Oak, thence
 East to a Black Jack, thence along Wadlows line to a
 corner on Millers line, thence to a White Oak corner — from
 wadlows line, thence to a Post Oak on the said line thence to
 the beginning. Together with all and singular the Rights
 Number three documents & appurtenances to the s^r. premises
