 George Benson at and before the sealing and delivery hereof  
 the Cop<sup>y</sup> whereof is here by acknowledged. Have given and  
 granted and by these Presents do freely give and grant  
 unto the said George Benson his heirs and Assigns one Negro  
 boy named Lawson which (before the signing of these pre-  
 sents) I have delivered to him the S<sup>r</sup> George Benson, with my  
 Own hand, to him the said George Benson his heirs Execu-  
 or Adm<sup>r</sup> without any manner of condition hindrance  
 or molestation from me or my heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> & Adm<sup>rs</sup> - In  
 witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the  
 twenty second day of October in the year of our Lord One  
 thousand Eight hundred and one - Signed sealed &
