 on lands granted to James Nicholson Esq<sup>m</sup>. I have such  
 shape and marks as are fairly designated by a plat  
 annexed to the original grant, which will fully and  
 at large appear reference being thereto made—  
 Together with all & singular the Rights members, hor-  
 ditaments and appurtenances to the said premises  
 belonging or in any wise appertaining: To have & to hold  
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the  
 said Nathan Waddle his heirs and assigns forever—  
 And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators  
 to warrant and defend all & singular the premises  
 unto the said Nathan Waddle his heirs & assigns against  
 myself & my heirs, & all other persons under by or for me, or  
 my heirs lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any  
 part thereof— W<sup>t</sup>chup my hand & seal this nineteenth day of  
 December in the year of Our Lord, One thousand eight hundred  
 & One & in the twenty fifth year of the Independence of the
