This Indenture made the seventh day of February one thousand
 seven hundred and ninety one between James Winn of the
 State of South Carolina and County of Fairfield of the one
 part and Thomas Gregory of Greenville County & State
 of South Carolina of the other part. Witnesseth that the said
 James Winn for and in consideration of the sum of
 three thousand three hundred pounds of Inspected
 Tobacco to him in hand paid by the said Thomas
 Gregory the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 in the said James Winn hath bargained and sold
 aliened and Confirmed and by these presents do
 bargain sell alien and Confirm unto the said
 Thomas Gregory his heirs & assigns forever all that
 Plantation or Tract of Land containing by
 estimation one hundred and fifty acres
 (more or less) situated in Greenville County lying
 on a branch of the North Side Reedy River &
 bounded as follows (to wit) beginning at a stake in
 David Milling line thence S 38. 72 Chains to a
 Corner history, thence W. 38. 72 Ch. to a stake in
 J^r. Shannon's line, thence N. 38. 72 Ch. to a corner
