 first pine Corner on said line thence a direct Course  
 to the beginning Gum Corner which includes the full  
 quantity of Land to be conveyed to said Owens it being a  
 part of a tract of Land of six hundred and forty acres  
 granted to John Mitcheson I do hereby warrant and  
 defend to have and to hold all and singular the premises  
 before mentioned to the S. Owens his heirs & assigns forever
