Sum of two hundred Silver Dollars to me paid by Alex.
Peacen of the State aforesaid and Greenville District have
granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do
grant bargain sell and release unto the said Alex. Peacen
all that Parcel, plantation or tract of land, situate lying
& being on the waters of Needy River containing one hundred
acres be the same more or less, it being part of a tract of
land containing 640 acres surveyed for John Buchanan
the 27th day of May 1784 by Thomas Lewis Dep. Sur. &
both such Shapes forms maps, as a plat hereunto annexed
with a reference running East 26.32 to a Stake, South 38.00
West 26.32, North 38.00 to a small hickory; & from the said
John Buchanan conveyed to the said William Chandler Junr.
Together with all and singular the rights members heredi-
taments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in any wise Incident or appertaining, to have & to
hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said Alex. Peacen his heirs and assigns
forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs
