 to a post oak, thence S. 30 E. 41 Ch. 24 Lks. to a Stake
 & thence to the beginning containing by estimation
 One hundred and forty acres, be the same more or
 less, being the N.W. end of a Tract of land granted
 to me the S. Barton by Patent bearing date the
 15th day of October 1784, for two Hundred Acres
 and whereon the said Cox now lives. Together
 with all and singular the Right members
 hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
 Premises belonging or in any wise ~~incidental~~
 or appertaining. To have and to hold all and
 singular the premises above mentioned unto the
 said Giles Cox his heirs and assigns for ever.

And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors
 & Administrators to warrant and forever defend
 all and singular the said Premises unto the
