 presents do grant bargain sell & Release
 unto the Ezekiel Cox a plantation or tract
 of land lying and being in the District
 aforesaid on both sides of Paddy Creek
 a branch of South Tyger River beginning
 at a light wood Stake corner & running
 thence N. 30 W. 41 Ch. 24 Links to a Spanis boat
 thence N. 60 E. 31. 62 Lk. to a post oak, thence S.
 30 E. 41 Lk. 24 Lk. to a Stake thence to the beginning
