This Indenture made this twelfth day of March in the year of our  
Lord One thousand seven hundred and ninety five, between Thomas Townson  
of Greenville county and State of South Carolina of the one part, and  
Daniel Kridler of the County and State aforesaid of the other part: Wit-  
nesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty pounds Sterling Mo-  
ney to him the said Thomas Townson in hand paid by the said Daniel Kridler  
the Receipt whereof he does hereby acknowledge and thereof and every part and  
part thereof do acquit and Discharge the said Daniel Kridler his heirs  
& assigns forever. Have given granted bargained and sold, and by these  
Presents Do give grant bargain sell Release Convey and Confirm unto the  
said Daniel Kridler his heirs & assigns forever, One certain Tract or parcel of  
Land lying and being in Greenville County and on the South West side of  
a branch called the Poplar bottom branch (it being a part of a Tract of Land  
originally granted to Mary Burns) Containing Eighty Acres or there more  
or less and bounded as followeth, to wit beginning at Andrew James' corner  
a Lightwood Stake in the original line, thence S 80 E. along the original line  
to a Red Oak Corner on a Small branch, thence down the said Branch as  
it Meanders to where it empties into the Poplar bottom branch, thence  
up the poplar bottom branch as it Meanders to Andrew Jones' corner black  
Beard on the bank of said branch, thence along said Jones' line to the  
first mentioned beginning: Together with all Houses, Orchards, Gardens, Meadows,  
pastures, feedings, fences Woods Ways waters and Water courses, Together with  
all the estate Right Title Interest possession claim and demand whatsoever of  
him the said Thomas Townson, in or the same, or any part of a parcel of the  
Reversion & Reversions Remainder & Remainders of all and singular the  
aforesaid mentioned Premises and every of their appurtenances: To have  
and to hold, the said Eighty Acres of Land more or less & Premises  
with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said Daniel Kridler  
his heirs and assigns forever. to their only proper use and behoof free &  
Clear from all incumbrances whatsoever & Further the said Thomas  
Townson for himself his heirs and assigns do covenant and agree to Warrant  
the said Daniel Kridler his heirs and assigns, that him, with the rights  
Title of the said Land & premises and every of their appurtenances  
against all persons or persons whatsoever will warrant and Defend.
