

Carolina & District of Greenville for Divers Causes have by mutual consent this day agreed to part, and for ever disannul our Marriage Contract, and we do bind ourselves our heirs &c. to return all the personal Estate that each of us possess at the time of our marriage except what has been made use of for supporting family to the rightful Owners before that date, & be it known from the date of these presents that no Contract made by each of the parties, shall in any manner effect the other; in which we again bind ourselves our heirs &c. in the sum of five thousand dollars strictly to perform, which shall be Recoverable of our heirs if default is made of either part
