Harrison did this day appear before me & on being privately & separately examined by me did declare that she did freely voluntarily and without any compulsion or fear of any Person or Persons whomsoever Renounce Release and for ever relinquish unto the within named James Harrison his heirs and assigns all her Interest and Estate, also all her Right & Claim of Dower of in or to and singular the Premises within mentioned and Released - Given under my hand & Seal this 19<sup>th</sup> day of March one thousand eight hundred & three.

State of South Carolina Greenville District. Memorandum, that on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March 1803. James Harrison Junr. Personally came before me a Justice for said District and made oath that he was present when this deed was signed, & did see the within named John H. Harrison sign & acknowledge the within deed to James Harrison and that he did also see Henry Harrison sign his name as also Benj. East as Evidence to the same Sworn & Subscribed to the before me Hudson Berry J. D. James Harrison Junr.

Know all men by these Presents that I Baylis Earle of Spartanburgh District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of one thousand dollars to me paid by John Earle of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid HAVE granted bargained sold and Released and by these Presents Do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Earle, All that Tract of Land Containing Seventy Acres be the same more or less Situate lying and being in the District of Greenville aforesaid on the waters of Oreeby River granted to the said Baylis Earle the Twelfth day of May Seventeen Hundred & Eighty seven as may appear on Record in the Secretaries Office of said State beginning on a Post Oak corner running thence S 75 W 11 Ch. 50 links to a Red Oak thence S 32 E 21, 50 to a stake thence N 80 W 34 Ch. 60 to a pine thence N 20 W 25 to a stake thence S 70 E 44 Ch. to the beginning bounded S. E. & S. W. on Jos. Whitners S. E. on Jas. Blairing and N. W. on Baylis Earle & Vacant Land - Also, all that piece or parcel of Land Situate lying and being in the District of said State adjoining the above mentioned Tract being part of a Tract of Five Hundred Acres granted to the said Baylis Earle the Twelfth day of July, Seventeen Hundred and Eighty four, Beginning on a Stake on the bank of Oreeby River, Running thence N. 76 W.
