Allister of County and State aforesaid of the other, part. Witnesseth that the s<sup>d</sup>. Wilson M<sup>c</sup>. Kinney for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars to him the s<sup>d</sup>. Wilson M<sup>c</sup>. Kinney in hand paid by the s<sup>d</sup>. Angus M<sup>c</sup>. Allister the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Wilson M<sup>c</sup>. Kinney hath granted bargained and sold, aliened released conveyed and confirmed, and this Present doth grant bargain and sell convey and confirm unto the said Angus M<sup>c</sup>. Allister his heirs and assigns for ever a Tract of land containing Two hundred and forty seven Acres, the same being granted to Esther Thomas the 15. day of October 1785. and duly recorded in the Secretaries office, said land laying on both sides of South Gate of Marsh Creek. Together with all the profits and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and all the Estate right title claim and demand whatsoever of him the s<sup>d</sup>. Wilson M<sup>c</sup>. Kinney of in and to the said tract of land and Premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Angus M<sup>c</sup>. Allister for ever. And the s<sup>d</sup>. Wilson M<sup>c</sup>. Kinney for him self and his heirs and against every of them unto the s<sup>d</sup>. Angus M<sup>c</sup>. Allister his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant from all other persons lawfully claiming the same. In Witness whereof he the said Wilson M<sup>c</sup>.
