Presents that I Francis Brown of the State and District aforesaid  
in consideration of one hundred dollars to me paid by Jesse  
Parker of the State and District have granted bargained sold and  
Released, and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and Release  
unto the said Jesse Parker, part of a tract of land supposed to be  
originally granted to W. Floyd, thence conveyed to W. Snow, then  
to Francis Brown, now from said Brown to J. Parker, That part of  
the tract that lies on the north side of the north fork of horse Creek  
the waters of Keedy River in the District aforesaid beginning on a  
Stake running on the original line N. 86<sup>th</sup> W. 10<sup>th</sup> to a haw wood thence  
S. 8<sup>th</sup> W. 70<sup>th</sup> to a Sweet gum thence down S. horse Creek S. 65<sup>th</sup> E. 21<sup>th</sup> 57<sup>th</sup> to a  
poplar thence N. 61<sup>th</sup> E. 10<sup>th</sup> 50<sup>th</sup> to a hickory, then N. 5<sup>th</sup> E. 38<sup>th</sup> to a post oak, then  
to the beginning, supposed to be fifty acres more or less. Together with  
all & singular the Rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the  
said Premises, belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining  
To have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto  
the said Jesse Parker his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do hereby  
bind myself my heirs Executor & Adm<sup>r</sup> to warrant and for ever de-  
fend all and singular the Premises unto the said Jesse Parker his  
heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs and against every other  
Person whomsoever claiming or to claim the same or any part  
thereof. Witness my hand and seal this second day of April 1803. & in  
the 24<sup>th</sup> Year of the Independence of the United States of America
