The State of South Carolina: Know all men by these Presents
that I Galib Campbell of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and
in consideration of four hundred dollars to me in hand paid by James Kilgore
of the State and District aforesaid, I the said Galib Campbell have granted
bargained sold and released, and by these Presents doth grant bargain sell
and Release unto the said James Kilgore, all that Tract or Parcel of lands
Containing Two hundred acres, Situate in the State and County aforesaid on the
N. fork of Durbins Creek some part of the said land was originally granted to
Wm. Gist and Confiscated the balance being a part of a Tract of three hundred
and twenty seven acres originally granted to James Wofford by Patton bearing date the
fourth day of July 1791. and Recorded in Grant Book D. N. 5. page 35. the lands
to be conveyed begins on a small Hickory Corner and runs S 75. E through a field
& over a branch to a Spanish Oak Corner, the length of said line is fifteen chains
thence S 18 W 8 chains & 25 links to a Chesnut Corner, thence S 10 E. & ch. 498 links, to
Sourwood Co. then N 78 W. nine chains to a Sunwood Corner, thence N. 53 W. 3. 65.
to Black oak Corner - then N. 77 W 9. 25. to a Stone Corner, then N. 40. W 24. 64
to a Red oak Corner, then S 87 W. 12. 72 to a Red oak Corner, then N. 41 W. 31. 37 to Pine
Corner then N. 50 E. 36. 50 to a Stone Corner on Stephen Howards line, then S 34 E
64 Chains to the Beginning Corner Hickory, which includes the full land
to be conveyed, Bounding on the S. W. by John Simms land on the N. by Stephen
Howards land and on the East and S. by William Goldsoniths land. Together with
all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
Premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining: To have and to hold all
and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said James Kilgore his heirs Executors
Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the Premises before
mentioned unto the said James Kilgore his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs & against every
person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my
hand & seal this 28th Feb. 1800. & in the twentyfourth year of American Independence
