The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I William Lacy of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of Eight hundred and seventy five dollars to me in hand paid by Henry Cook Senr. of the State of North Carolina and Chatham County I have granted bargained and sold and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto said Henry Cook Senr. all that Tract or Plantation of Land containing Four hundred and ninety acres part of which being a part of a Tract of 35<sup>ans</sup> originally granted to Nathl Reed the fifth day of June 1786. and Recorded in Grant Book M. M. M. the balance being a part of a Tract of four hundred and sixty three acres of originally granted to James Harrison, the fifth day of March 1792, which will more fully appear by a deed from said Harrison to William Lacy bearing date the 4<sup>th</sup> day of November 1790 all of which Situate in the State and district aforesaid on both sides of Rocky Creek on the branches thereof waters of Uddy River, beginning on Indianish Cooks Red oak Corner, and runs N. 20 W. 97 chains to a Spanish Oak Corner thence South 70 W. 27 to a Spanish Oak corner, thence S 20 E 40 50 to a Stake Corner, thence West 43.
