


one Certain tract or parcel of Land situate Lying and being in Greenville District aforesaid and on a bank of Saluda River it being part of a tract granted by his Excellency Edward Rutledge Governor and Commander in Chief to Abram Bladsoe dated the second day of September one thousand Seven hundred and Ninety Nine is bounded as followeth to wit Beginning on a white Oak a Condition Corner thence running to a marked pine and to continue that Course to Crisp line thence along his line to a red oak thence along the top of a Ridge a Conditional line between Bladsoe and said Sawyer to the line south east Coast thence along that line till it comes opposite one other marked pine so as to run a straight Course by the laste marked pine to the beginning Containing one hundred acres the same more or less to have and to hold the aforesaid grantee singly or in any wise appertaining thence unto the said Samuel Livingood his heirs and assigns for ever and the said William Sawyer for himself his heirs and assigns against the just Claim of any other person or persons in testimony whereof the said the sd William Sawyer hath hereunto set his hand and seal this Eighteenth day of August 1801. and signed sealed and delivered in the presence of us Just Abraham Blythe
