 & Four between Thomas Nichols the State of S. Carolina & Greenville District of the  
 me part & Robert Benson for the consideration of three hundred Dollars paid to him  
 in hand paid by the S<sup>r</sup> Robert Benson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged & I the  
 said Thomas Nichols have granted a bargain & sale unto the S<sup>r</sup> Robert Benson  
 a certain tract or parcel of Land containing three hundred acres more or less lying in  
 the District aforesaid on Mill Shoal Creek of Moore river being part of a tract of Land  
 Granted to Lachariah White & hath such shapes forms marks & bound as a plat there  
 unto annexed represents & Recorded in Secretaries office in Grant book 9999 Beginning  
 on Enoch Kitchens corner on a black Oak thence to a white Oak S. E. to a black oak  
 thence to a swampy Oak N. W. thence to a white Oak N. E. to a gum S. E. thence to a pyp  
 -lar S. E. thence to a pine S. W. thence to the Beginning which by estimation contain  
 three hundred acres more or less, & I the said Thomas Nichols will warrant & for  
 ever defend the above mentioned tract of land to the said Robert Benson free &  
 clear from me my heirs & from every other person or persons whatever laying  
 legal claim to the same. In witness whereof I have set my hand & seal the day  
 of date above mentioned sign'd, seal'd, and delivered in the presents of  
 us Test<sup>r</sup> Thomas Springfield
