one part & Robert Benson for the consideration of three hundred Dollars paid to him  
in hand paid by the S<sup>r</sup> Robert Benson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged & the  
said Thomas Nichols have granted bargain<sup>d</sup> & sold unto the S<sup>r</sup> Robert Benson  
a certain tract or parcel of land containing three hundred acres more or less lying in  
the District aforesaid on mill hole Creek of Enore river being part of a tract of Land  
Granted to Zachariah White & that such shapes forms marks & bounds as a plot there  
unto annexed represents & Recorded in Secretaries office in Grant book 9999 Beginning  
on Enock Bensons corner on a black Oak thence to a white Oak S. E. to a black oak  
thence to a swampy Oak N. W. thence to a white Oak N. E. to a gum S. E. thence to a pop-  
-lar S. E. thence to a pine S. W. thence to the Beginning which by Estimation contains  
three hundred acres more or less, & the said Thomas Nichols will warrant & for-  
ever defend the above mentioned tract of land to the said Robert Benson free &  
Clear from me my heirs & from every other person or persons whatsoever Laying  
legal Claims to the same. In witness whereof I have set my hand & seal the day  
& date above mentioned sign<sup>d</sup> seal<sup>d</sup> and Delivered in the presents of
