John Archer one Lot of Land situated lying & being in the Village of Pleasantburg known & distinguished in the plan or chart of S^t. Village by Number 47 fronting on the East side of the said house street, Beginning on a Stake and running thence N^o 10^r E^o 10^r feet to a Stake thence S^o 74^r E^o 17^r feet to a Stake thence S^o 15^r W^o 100 feet to a Stake thence N^o 74^r W^o 17^r feet to the Beginning containing one half acre by the same man or less which said it was conveyed from Col. Aston to Dr. Wood from Wood to Thomas Alexander from Alexander to Jesse Goodlett & from Goodlett to me. Together with all & singular the rights, members, instruments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Archer his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my self my heirs & executors & Administrators to warrant and a power defend all and singular the said premises unto the S^t. John Archer his heirs and assigns Against myself my heirs and Against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming unto claim the same or any part thereof. Ruby of bumbleland in consideration of fifty pounds current Sterling Money to me paid by Isaiah Garrison of Greenville County & State of South Carolina, HAVE granted bargained sold and released unto these presents as Grant bargain sell and release unto the said Isaiah Garrison all that part of a certain tract of Land Originally Granted to the S^t. S. Ruby for 400 acres lying & being in the County of Greenville bearing & bounded on the South & on ready river, all that part of said Original Tract Viz. Beginning on the lower corner a branch on the original line & on a small hickory tree on the original line S. E. 3; forty one chain to a pine the original corner, thence N. W. 63° on the original line so far as will intersect with Thomas Terry's land from thence on Thomas Terry's line south westerly to a Stake thence S. E. 145° along a line of marked trees to the Beginning containing one hundred acres to the same more or less, Together with all & singular the rights members, instruments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned to the said Isaiah Garrison his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and a power apon all & singular the said premises unto the said
