Have granted bargain sold released and conveyed & by these presents Do Grant bargain sell & release unto the said William Yarber a plantation or tract of land lying & being in Greenville District & State aforesaid on the Beaver Dam Creek of Sugar and being part of a tract of land granted to Francis Dadds & by William Dadd sole Executor of Francis Dadds conveyed by a deed of Lease to George Grayham on the twenty eighth day of October in the year one thousand seven hundred & ninety seven & the said Geo. Grayham conveyed by a deed unto the said Solomon Loftice on the twenty eighth day of November in the year one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven & by the said Solomon Loftice conveyed by a deed unto the said Archibald Holcombe on the Saturday day of February in the year one thousand seven hundred & ninety nine Beginning on a red Oak main between Archibald Holcombe & Null Running thence South & a hickory corner made when Abraham Randles Land was laid off a part of the Original tract thence along Randles line to a maple corner thence along Stephen Dills line as it crosses Goes to the old line at a lower wood corner made when Dills part was laid off thence along the old line to a Conditional corner on a red Oak thence to a post Oak corner thence South to the Beginning corner containing one hundred acres more or less, Together with all and singular the sites Hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Yarber his heirs & assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and assigns to Warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the said Wm Yarber his heirs & assigns Against myself & my heirs & against all & every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the said premises or any part thereof, In Witness whereof I the said Archibald Holcombe have hereunto set my hand & affixt my seal this twenty fifth day of January one thousand Eight hundred and four The Witnesses
