

State of South Carolina - I know all now by these presents that I James Sampson
of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid. In consideration of the sum of
twenty Dollars to me paid by Samuel Brasher of the County & State aforesaid -
Have granted bargained sold & released And by these presents Do grant bargain sell & release
unto the said Samuel Brasher Thirty Acres of Land more or less being part of a tract
of five hundred acres Originally Granted to Robert Gillow & signed by his Excellency
Thomas Pinckney the seventh day of April One thousand seven hundred and
Eighty Eight situated in the County of Greenville on Bakers fork of the Rudey fork
of Rudey river. The said a thirty acres more or less being laid out to the sd Samuel
Brasher as follows. Beginning on a black oak corner of the Original line and
running N. 62. E. 15. chains on the said Original line to a Stake corner near the Shoal
there running N. 28. E. 21. 50^l. to a post oak corner. there running S. 62. E. 15 to a stone
or oak corner on the Original line. there running S. 28. W. 21. ch. 50. lds to the -
Beginning including thirty acres more or less. Together with all & singular
the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or
in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all & singular the
premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel Brasher his heirs & assigns forever
& I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant & for
ever defend all & singular the said thirty acres of land more or less with the
premises unto the said Samuel Brasher his heirs and assigns against myself my
heirs & assigns. and all and every other person or persons whatsoever In Witness
