that I Thomas Brummitt of the State and District aforesaid in consideration  
of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Jesse May-  
field of the said State and District aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and  
released, and by these Presents do Grant bargain sell and release unto the  
said Jesse Mayfield, part of that tract or parcel of land lying and being on  
the middle fork of Saluda River, granted unto me by his excellency William  
Moultrie on the fourth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand  
seven hundred and eighty five, including the greatest part of the fields now  
in cultivation by said Jesse Mayfield, beginning upon a white oak corner  
tree of my land, and upon Governor's line, thence up the river to a Hickory
